#### D7095 Surface Mounted Restraining Stay

As a result of customer demand we have decided to produce a surface mounted version of the already popular D6095 mortice restraining stay for doors. It has the same features as the D6095 mortice version with its adjustable friction block and restricted opening of the door around 90 degrees depending upon the fixing position. With its slimline channel and arm assembly that can have a variety of plated finishes, it offers a very discreet and aesthetically pleasing design to complement any finished door. More importantly as fitting only takes a few minutes a considerable time and cost saving can be made by the door manufacturer/end user.

Surface mounted so quick and easy install

Suitable for timber, aluminium or steel

Adjustable friction

Allows opening between 90-100 degrees

Available in a variety of plated finishes for both the channel and arm assembly

#### PH381 Electronic Outside Access

Until now projects having escape doors that are also required to have access control have involved either using an electric striker or an electric panic device linked to the access control system which both work fine but are limited to only offering single point devices.

Now, with the introduction of the PH381 electronic outside access device can be used with 2 or 3 point devices as well as single point devices from the push bar, push pad and touch bar range. The unit can be linked to a variety of access control systems including swipe card entry and proximity readers.

The unit has adjustable timed opening of 3 – 20 seconds with the opening indicated by means of a green LED and audible signal allowing engagement of the lever for entry. There is also mechanical key over-ride as standard.
